



PROGRAM OUTLINE

ENTRANCE (Hope House)

- Applicant is mailed application form to complete and mail, fax or bring to Program Director for review.
- Acceptance or denial letter will be mailed back to applicant. Upon acceptance, persons name will be added to the waiting list, or the person will be accepted immediately into the program.
- In-depth intake forms will be completed and interview with Program Director.
- Non-refundable \$800 entrance fee will be paid.
- Tour, overall rules and guidelines reviewed, settle in.

Level I (Hope House)

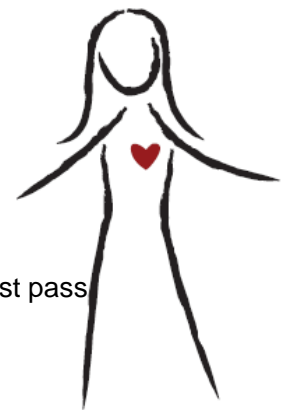
4 – 6 Weeks ~ Probation Period

- Start the process of getting I.D. or Driver's License, Social Security Card, food stamps. Confirm all court dates, fines, meetings with DHR, Court Referral and other organizations, and set these up with RWO Client Representative.
- Required to attend ALL classes, meet with counseling services, and GED classes if needed.
- Participate in cooking, cleaning, gardening, shopping, yoga and walking
- No outside employment is allowed at this time unless approved by director.
- No personal phone calls (except for sponsors), no visitation or passes during this period.
- Participate in Community Service.
- Required to attend one if not more 12-Step meetings daily. Each resident MUST attend 90 meetings in 90 days. *if not working must attend all meetings*

Level II (Hope House)

6 – 10 Weeks ~ Restoration Begins

- Work through steps one, two and three. Start "A Women's Walk Thru 12 Steps".
- Attend all classes and counseling sessions.
- Participate in cooking, cleaning, gardening, shopping, yoga and walking.
- Attend GED classes.
- Attend 12-Step meetings daily.
- Involvement in group counseling will be a must.
- Meet with RWO Client Representative at least once per week.
- One – 10 minute phone call per week will be allowed.
- One – 3 hour pass each week will be given during this level with approval of the Program Director.



Level III (Hope House)

10 – 13 Weeks ~ Setting Life Goals

- Work through steps four, five and six. Start _____
- If you have not already earned your GED, enroll in classes if needed. You must pass Your GED exam in order to graduate the RWO Program.
- Attend 12-Step meetings, classes and counseling sessions.
- Marriage and family counseling if needed.
- Participate in parenting and marriage classes; budget and goal setting workshop; and workout programs
- Meet with RWO Client Representative weekly.
- Two – 3 hour passes, as well as two –8 hour pass will be given during this level with approval of the Program Director.
- Two– 10 minute phone call per week will be allowed.

Level IV (Hope House)

13 – 17 Weeks ~ Becoming Stable

- Work through steps seven, eight and nine.
- Attend all 12-Step meetings and classes.
- Continue participate in parenting, marriage, budget and goal setting, and workouts
- Continue to meet with counselor, sponsors and mentors on a weekly basis.
- Meet with RWO Client Representative bi-weekly.
- Two –8 hour pass, and two – 24 hour pass per month may be taken during this level with approval from the Program Director.
- One – 10 minute phone calls per day will be allowed.

Level V (Frady House)

16 – 24 Weeks ~ Moving Forward

- Transition to Frady House after 8 months and phasing up to Level V if approved by Program Director.
- This level is designed to move you forward in your life and back into society as a positive, confident and restored woman. Therefore, the guidelines for this level will adapt to each resident's own progression and completion of life goals set in Level III.
- Must obtain GED before completion of this level.
- Attend all 12-Step meetings and classes.
- Participate in Parenting, Marriage, Budget and Goal Setting, and Workouts
- Full-time employment will be required.
- Two – 48 hour passes, and two – 8 hour passes per month may be taken during this level with approval from the Program Director.
- Personal phone may be allowed at this level if approved by Program Director and purchased by resident.
- Residents will be expected to perform 8 hours of community service at this level.

- ∞ Total program may vary depending on each resident's needs. All curriculums are 12-Step or Bible based. Drug and alcohol tests will be given often and at random.

- ∞ Passes will be given by the Program Director, according to each resident's environmental circumstance.
- ∞ Each resident will be monitored at all times, and all rules of Restoring Women Outreach will be enforced without discrimination.
